## Covid 19 Range Opening Template

### LEGALITY

NRA is opening Bisley 23 May and NSRA is saying ok to open. The following guidelines incorporate pertinent NRA, NRSA and National Police recommendations and input from committee members. NSRA provides our insurance and their website confirms we covered for Covid 19 so long as we mitigate the risk. Paul Wright checked with Lincolnshire police regarding clay shooting and they had no problem with resuming so long as the opening was consistent with government guidance. Deputy Chief Constable Dave Orford, the national lead on firearms licensing, is issuing clear instructions to individual constabularies that shooting can take place under the current regulations as long as social distancing guidelines are adhered to.

### COVID 19 SYMPTOMS

If you are feeling unwell or have Covid 19 symptoms please do not visit the range, no matter how mild the symptoms. The guidelines say that if you are displaying symptoms yourself you must isolate for 7 days. If you are sharing a household with someone who is displaying symptoms you must isolate for 14 days. Anyone experiencing a new, continuous cough; high temperature; and now also a loss of or change in your normal sense of smell or taste can book a test by visiting [www.nhs.uk/coronavirus](http://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus)

### BOOKING & RANGE OPERATION

- online system to reserve slot with telephone option for non internet users
- no booking, no access allowed to range
- members only, no guests
- maximum of 3 people shooting on 75m range
- maximum of 3 people shooting on 25m range
- maximum of 2 on Practical Shotgun with only one shooting (only allowed on main range during setup and breakdown)
- maximum of 2 on each Clay trap with only one shooting (only allowed on main range during setup and breakdown)
- there will be a 5 minute staggered start for each "lane" on all four ranges eg 10:00, 10:05 etc
- the booking slots will be every 95 minutes
- you will have 90 minutes on range to setup, shoot, pack away and leave
- a safety officer (SO) will be in the parking area controlling access and completing attendance records
- only arrive at your allotted start time and wait in car until approached by SO
- enter the 75/25m range via the bridge and return to your car via the long drive
- one RCO on main range and self-manage RO duty on Clay and Practical Shotgun
- wait for RCO permission to enter the firing point area

## **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

- maintain social distancing guidance at all times
- if talking to another member avoid standing face to face
- minimum of two empty lanes between shooters on 75/25 ranges
- one shooter per lane on 75/25 ranges
- leave range when cleared by RCO ie no group chats

## **USE & PROVISION OF CLUB EQUIPMENT**

- the cabin and toilets off limits to everyone apart from the RCO & SO
- no club guns, ammunition, range mats or other equipment apart from staple guns, seats and targets
- club to provide SO & RCO with face masks and protective gloves
- members bring own food and refreshments
- members bring own hand sanitiser
- we will provide surface cleaner for each shooter to use on equipment in their lane
